About Us

The CHP 11-99 Foundation was founded in 1982 by philanthropist Bob Weinberg to provide emergency assistance to California Highway Patrol employees and their families and scholarships to their children.

Over \$42 million in assistance has been distributed to CHP families in the past 40 years, including more than \$35 million in vocational and academic scholarships to children or dependents of CHP active or retired (living) employees.

The CHP 11-99 Foundation is an IRS-recognized 501(c)(3) nonprofit, charitable organization. We rely on private donations and grants from donors and organizations to sustain our programs each year.



Who Qualifies & How?

Any current, active employee of the CHP (uniformed or civilian) may apply to receive financial assistance.

Apply directly through your Commander. Signed memos by all supervisors outlining the request and circumstance must then be sent to our CHP Departmental Liaison for internal review.

All requests are assessed on a case-bycase basis and entirely confidential.
